

Texas Junior Brahman Association Scholarship Program

The Texas Junior Brahman Association will operate a program to award scholarships to worthy recipients who have made outstanding contributions to agriculture and the Brahman breed. Recipients will be announced during the annual TJBA State Show Awards Banquet.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. Applicants must be an active member of the Texas Junior Brahman Association (TJBA) and must have been an exhibitor at the State Show for at least two years.
2. Applicants must be a high school senior in the year the application is submitted.
3. Applicants are required to submit a completed scholarship application, a brief essay as to why they believe they are deserving of this scholarship, a copy of their official high school transcript that includes grades from the most recent grading period, and one letter of recommendation.
4. Completed applications and other documents must be mailed to TJBA, P.O. Box 26, Campbellton, TX 78008 and be postmarked not later than May 1, 2020.
5. MUST BE PRESENT AT 2020 TJBA STATE SHOW SCHOLARSHIP INTERVIEWS ON WEDNESDAY, JUNE 17, 2020, TO BE CONSIDERED FOR A SCHOLARSHIP. INTERVIEWS WILL NOT BE CONDUCTED BY TELEPHONE, SKYPE, OR ANY OTHER METHOD THAN FACE-TO-FACE.

Selection:

The TJBA Scholarship Committee, appointed by the TBA President, will review applications, conduct interviews with applicants, and select recipients. The Scholarship Committee will interview applicants face-to-face during the TJBA State Show. All decisions of the Committee shall be final.

Point System:

TJBA scholarship applicants shall be scored on a 100-point system, allocated as follows:

1. TJBA Involvement (35 points)
2. Interview (25 points)
3. Grades (25 points)
4. Written Essay (15 points)
