Brazos County Expo Center – Bryan, Texas December 20 - 21, 2020

postmarked by December 10 and will be posted at check-in)

Junior Division followed by Senior Division in Ring A Minor Division followed by Major Division in Ring B

Entry fee, \$10/exhibitor paid at the gate (winner gets half

the pot, prizes to second and third in each division)

Pee Wee Division follows (no entry fee, prizes awarded)

After Showmanship Ring A Red Brahmans, followed by Grey Brahmans

Ring B Red Brahmans, followed by Grey Brahmans

NOTE: Ring B Red Brahmans will begin after the conclusion of the Ring A Red Brahman show



TJBA HOLIDAY SHOW GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Texas Junior Brahman Association reserves to its Show Chairman or designee the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and to arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions and differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of or connected with or incident to the show, and the right to amend or add to these rules as its judgment may determine. An exhibitor who violates any of the following rules will forfeit all privileges and premiums.

- 1. Eligibility of Exhibitors: To be eligible for the Holiday Show, boys or girls MUST BE ACTIVE MEMBERS OF THE TEXAS JUNIOR BRAHMAN ASSOCIATION and be at least eight (8) years of age as of December 21, 2020 and up to and including 2021 high school seniors.
- 2. Eligibility of Cattle: (a) Animals entered must be registered in the herd book of the American Brahman Breeders Association. Females must be born on or between September 1, 2018 and June 30, 2020. (b) Animals' registration papers must be in the name of the exhibitor. (c) Animals must have been raised or purchased by the exhibitor and must have been prepared for the show by the exhibitor. (d) Animals must be firebranded with same holding brand and private herd number indicated on ABBA registration paper.
- 3. Entry Fees and Deadline: All entries must be mailed to TJBA and postmarked by DECEMBER 10, 2020. An entry fee of \$40.00 per head must accompany the entry form for the Ring A show, or \$70 per head for both Ring A and Ring B. Showmanship entry fee is \$10.00 and is payable at the gate (do not mail with entries). LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ASSESSED A \$15 PER HEAD PER RING LATE FEE. Make checks payable to TJBA. There will be no refund on entry fees.
- **4. Liability Statement and Waiver**: Form is included in the entry packet. This form must be read, signed and returned to be accepted into the show. All owners and those in charge of property of livestock shall care for, guard, protect and preserve the same. TJBA management or agents will not be held responsible for any loss, injury, or damage that may occur to any person, livestock or property.
- **5. COVID Release**: It is included in the entry packet. This form must be read, signed and returned to be accepted into the show.
- 6. Arrival, Check-in, and Release of Cattle: Show grounds will be open for arrival of cattle Sunday, December 20, 2020 at 1:00 PM. All entries must be in place and original registration papers checked in by 7:00 PM, Sunday, December 20, 2020 unless provisions have been made with Show Chairmen due to extenuating circumstances. Entries will be released at the discretion of the exhibitor.
- 7. Stalling: Stalls will be on a first-come, first-served basis in the East Pavilion. Please do not take more space than required and please keep the tack, feed, and stall set-up equipment to a minimum.
- 8. All entries in the show must be exhibited by the individual owner, with the following exception: When an exhibitor has more than one entry in one class or is not able to show due to sickness, has two entries exhibiting in separate rings at the same time, temporary physical handicap, or extreme family emergencies, another TJBA member may show in his/her place. All exceptions must be cleared with Show Chairmen or designee prior to entering the ring.
- 9. The decision of the judge shall be final in all cases: In cases where fraud, misrepresentation, error or collusion is discovered after awards have been given, the Show Chairman or designee may make a decision regarding final placement.

- 10. If any exhibitor or his representative interferes in any way with the judge or shows disrespect to him/her or to the show, the exhibitor may be dismissed from the ring and the management may withhold from said exhibitor any premium moneys that may have been awarded or take other steps deemed necessary.
- 11. Judging will not be delayed for animals entering the arena late: Any exhibit not presented promptly at the scheduled time may be barred from competition in the class. Protests that the judged overlooked the exhibit will not be considered.
- **12. Unruly Entries:** Any entry that is unruly and poses danger to other exhibitors, or if exhibitor loses control of their animal <u>twice</u> during the class, the animal will be dismissed from the show arena by the judge or arena director or designee.
- **13.** Females will show in three age categories calf, junior and senior. A minimum of three classes per division will be offered in each ring.
- **14. Color Classification:** The TJBA Holiday Show will have a grey division and red division for females. Entries will be classified based on color designated on the ABBA registration certificate.
- **15. NO DOGS will be allowed on the show grounds.** This rule will be enforced for the protection and safety of all cattle and people. Dogs must be left at home.
- 16. Protest: All protests MUST BE IN WRITING AND BE ACCOMPANIED BY A DEPOSIT OF \$100.00 which will be forfeited if protest is not sustained. Such protest must state plainly the cause of complaint or appeal, and must be delivered to the show rules committee immediately after occasion for each protest. Depending on the basis of the protest, a decision may be withheld until a complete investigation is done. All protests will be directed to a grievance committee. Grievance Committee will be named by the TBA President. Additional members may be appointed by the permanent grievance committee members on an ad hoc basis.
- 17. Dress Code: Contestants are required to wear appropriate show ring attire jeans, collared shirt that must be tucked in, and dark shoes or boots. No baseball caps, no white on shoes and no t-shirts will be allowed. This rule applies to showmanship as well as the regular and B&O shows. Exhibitor dress will be checked at the gate prior to entering the show arena.
- **18. Health Requirements:** Health papers are NOT REQUIRED for the Holiday Show. Check with your vet for health regulations or www.tahc.state.tx.us.
- 19. Any issue not covered in these rules will be governed by the 2020 AJBA "All American" show rules. In the event those rules do not cover the issue, the Grievance Committee shall make the decision.
- 20. Exhibitor Divisions for Showmanship: Exhibitors will compete in one of four age-determined categories: Junior, Minor, Major, and Senior. To keep competition among divisions as fair as possible, the age breaks for exhibitor divisions will not be determined until the December 10 entry deadline. Divisions will be broken to place as close to one-fourth of the exhibitors entered in each of the four divisions. Once determined, the age breaks will be posted on www.texasbrahmans.com and the TJBA Facebook page.
- 21. NO cable halters will be permitted.
